## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH COMMERCIAL STREET TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary prohibition of driving on Commercial Street from its junction with Vulcan Street for a distance of approx. 100m in a westerly direction because of MBC regeneration works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being Gray Street, Lower East Street and Pioneering Way.

The road will be closed on 04/01/2022 for up to 18 months. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
