

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
(ARCTIC MONKEYS CONCERT)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (the Council) gives notice that it has made an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clause Act 1847 and any other enabling powers affecting those lengths of road listed in Schedule 1 below due to the Arctic Monkeys Concert at the Riverside Stadium. The lengths of road shall be closed to all vehicular traffic on the dates and times specified therein.

Exemptions to the closures specified in Schedule 1 shall apply to any vehicle used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. Access to properties adjoining the lengths of road will not be affected by the Order.

All diversion routes shall be signposted on site. Pedestrian access shall be maintained at all times.

**SCHEDULE 1:
ROADS TO BE CLOSED ON MONDAY 5TH JUNE 2023 BETWEEN 11:00 HOURS AND 23:59 HOURS AS REQUIRED**

Road Affected	Description
A66 eastbound exit slip road at Middlehaven Interchange	Full length.
Cargo Fleet Road	Full length.
Commercial Street	Prohibition of westbound traffic to the west of the Gray Street junction.
Dockside Road	From its junction with Marsh Road (adjacent to Whitehouse Level Crossing) for a distance of approximately 200 metres in an easterly direction.
Heath Road	Full length.
Lower East Street	Westbound traffic only between the Gray Street and Durham Street junctions.
Marsh Road	Full length.
Vulcan Street	Prohibition of northbound and southbound traffic to the north of the Commercial Street junction.
Priestman Road	From its junction with Dock Street for a distance of approximately 450 metres in a south easterly direction.
Shepherdson Way	Full length.
The Halyard	Full length.
The Leeway	Full length.
Windward Way	From its junction with The Halyard for a distance of approximately 70 metres in a westerly direction.
