NOTICE OF DEED OF DEDICATION OF A CYCLE TRACK AT RIDGEWAY, COULBY NEWHAM, MIDDLESBROUGH

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough has dedicated with effect from 1st March 2022, a new Cycle Track (with pedestrian rights) maintainable at public expense between Ridgeway to the north and The Birches to the south in the Coulby Newham area of Middlesbrough as described in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

The cycle track commences at its junction with the B1365 at Grid ref. NZ 5032 / 1414 (Point A on the plan) then proceeds in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 210 metres across an area of open grassed land between Ridgeway to the north and The Birches to the south and continuing to its junction with the cycle path to the rear of No. 14 Woodlea at Grid Ref NZ 5050 / 1426 (Point B on the plan) a total distance of approximately 210 metres.

Width: 3.6 Metres

Legal Right: Cycle Track with Pedestrian Rights
