**NEWHAM WAY, COULBY NEWHAM – PROPOSED TIGER CROSSING**

As part of its ongoing commitment to reduce the number and severity of casualties on the Borough's road network and encourage local journeys to be made by more sustainable alternatives to the private car, Middlesbrough Council is proposing to introduce a new 'tiger' crossing on Newham Way in Coulby Newham, approx. 100m west from the Wykeham Way junction.

A "Tiger Crossing" is a new type of facility, which combines a pedestrian zebra with a crossing alongside for cyclists. The attached plan shows the proposals, designed to continue the provision of pedestrian and cycle facilities along this section of Newham Way, to address concerns expressed by local residents and Ward Councillors regarding pedestrian safety.

The crossing will be situated on the line of the existing footpath / cyclepath from Newham Grange Farm to Hazelbank. We are intending that the crossing flashing light beacons will be screened from the side to ensure that the occupiers of nearby properties are not disturbed during the hours of darkness. Funding for the scheme has been secured from the Council's 2020/21 Capital Programme.

As is the case for all improvements to the Borough's road network, a public consultation exercise is being carried out in order to determine whether the proposed scheme will have any major impact on surrounding properties prior to the implementation stage. As an occupier of a property in the vicinity of the crossing point, I would welcome your views on this proposal.
